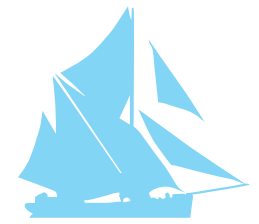


2 Day Cruise on Thames Sailing Barge Thalatta On Friday 13 - Saturday 14 July

A unique opportunity to join us and explore the creeks and rivers of the East Coast.

Where we go depends on the wind and tide but the choice of where we find a quiet anchorage for the night after a day sailing offshore ranges from the rivers Alde, Ore, Deben, Blackwater, Orwell & Stour through to the famous “Swallows & Amazons” Walton Backwaters.

Each trip is limited to a maximum of 12 guests. This ensures that everyone can be actively involved in all aspects of sailing the vessel from sail handling and steering through to navigation and pilotage.



Built in Harwich in 1906, Thalatta was fully rebuilt in 2012 and is now one of the finest and well equipped barges afloat. As in her days carrying cargo she is crewed by a skipper, Mate and a Third Hand. Now converted to provide educational cruises for children she has comfortable hammocks for overnight and is fitted out with a large galley and all modern facilities.

Accommodation, food and refreshments for the duration of the cruise will be provided for an inclusive price of £ 200 per person

Departure will be from Ipswich Haven Marina at 0830 am on Friday and we will return around 4.30 pm (ish) on Saturday.
