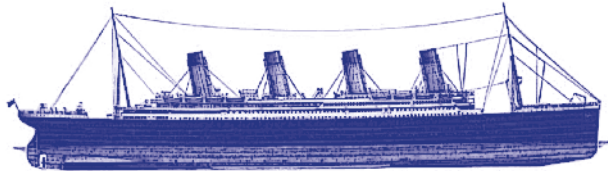


# Ships in 1906

What kind of ships were on the water with *Thalatta*?

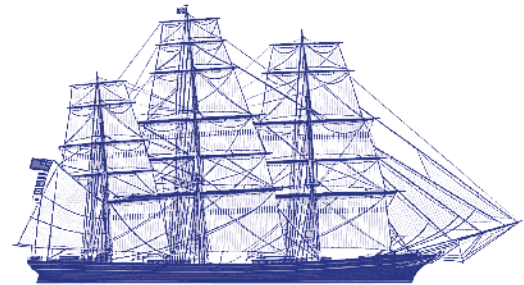

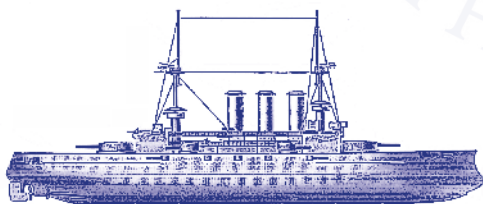
*Titanic – a luxury cruise liner*

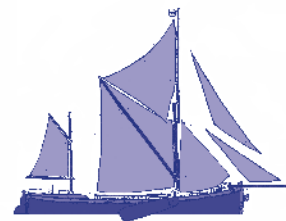
*Cutty Sark – a fast cargo ship*
